**Scholarships:**

Each school year there are a few scholarship discounts that are available through the school. If you are interested in applying for a tuition scholarship discount for the 2008-2009 school year, please ask for an application from the office. Please submit requests by the last day of school. They will be reviewed at the July board meeting. All requests are confidential and reviewed only by the board. Scholarship discounts are given based on a family's financial need, history with the school, parent commitment towards the school in terms of volunteer hours, and the ability of the school's budget to accommodate the requests. Both Elementary and Primary requests are accepted.
